

# **The International Conference on “Environmental Change and Management in Disruptive Age” Full Paper and Presentation Guidelines**

## **1. Introduction**

Papers must be prepared in English. Papers should clearly describe the background of the subject, the objectives of the paper and related headings. Research based articles should include the methods used, results and concluding discussion.

## **2. Paper and Slide Submission**

All papers and PowerPoint slides for presentation should be submitted electronically in Microsoft Word format and Microsoft PowerPoint format. The submission should be made to the given e-mail address at the given deadline. The contact e-mail addresses for paper submission is [nida.c@nida.ac.th](mailto:nida.c@nida.ac.th)

## **3. Length of Paper and Presentation**

The number of pages of each paper should not exceed 20 pages including tables, figures and references. The presentation time for each presenter is 15-20 minutes plus 5 minutes for discussion.

## **4. Paper Format**

### **4.1 Fonts Used**

Papers should use Times New Roman font with the following font sizes:

- 1). The paper title should be 16 point and bold;
- 2). The author names should be 11 point with bold characters;
- 3). The authors' affiliated institution and e-mail addresses should be 10 point, without bold;
- 4). The heading of each section should be 14 point and bold;
- 5). The content should be 12 point.

### **4.2 Table and Figures**

Tables and figures should be placed close to their first citation in the text. All figures and tables should be numbered. Table headings should be centred and placed above the tables. Figure captions should be centred and placed below the figures.

### **4.3 Equations**

If applicable, each equation should be presented on a separate line from the text. Equations should be clearly written and expressions should be explained in the text. The equations should be numbered consecutively at the outer right margin, as shown in Eqs. (1) - (2) below.

$$P_1 = \frac{1}{N} \sum_{i=1}^N \left( \frac{G_n}{z} \right), G_n = (z - y_i) \cdot I(y_i \leq z). \quad (1)$$

$$Y = y(K, L) \quad (2)$$

#### 4.4 References

Each reference should be put in brackets in the content and sequentially numbered at the end of the article. Typical examples of full references at the end of the article are:

- 1) Journal references consist of: name of author (s); year; article title; journal name; volume; issue number; and page number (s);
- 2) Book references consist of: name of author (s); year of publication; title; edition; location and publisher;
- 3) Proceeding references consist of: name of author (s); article title; conference title; venue; country; date; location and publisher.
