Call for Presentation

Now accepting abstract submissions in any area related to global change, environment and sustainability. The accepted abstracts will be presented as poster presentations and included in the official conference abstract book. The deadline for abstract submission is December 10, 2015. The Poster Prize will be presented to the best poster at the conference.

Conference Topics

The conference welcomes presentation contributions describing projects which highlight the latest research and innovation in global change, environment, and sustainability. Coverage includes (1) Environmental Science and Technology, (2) Environmental Policy, Planning and Management, (3) Environmental Laws and Ethics, (4) Pollutions, (5) Environmental and Natural Resources Economics, (6) Environmental Governance, (7) Environmental Assessment, (8) Environmental Management, and (9) Other interesting topics in Global Change, Environment, and Sustainability. In addition, presentations that are interdisciplinary or integrated studies with other fields of science or social sciences will also be considered.

Abstract Format

A maximum of 2 pages (A4) extended abstract may be submitted. The extended abstract includes (1) Title, (2) Author(s), (3) Affiliation(s), (4) text body, (5) up to 3 keywords, (6) references (if any), and (7) Figures and Tables (if any). Please use Times New Roman 12-point font, double spaced, 1-inch (2.5 cm) margin all around. The abstract submission must be in Microsoft Word (.doc, .docx) for a possible typeset editing by conference staff. Abstract submission can be made by e-mailing to sawat.sat@ics.nida.ac.th

Once accepted, the conference will notify the authors immediately.

Poster Preparation

Each presenter can arrange poster in his/her own preference layout. However, the poster must be prepared in English language only. Poster board with a 90 cm high by 60 cm wide size is provided so it is recommended that poster should be prepared in A1 paper size (59 X 84 cm). Poster numbers will be assigned to each presenter.

The presentation must cover the material as cited in the abstract. Please place title of the poster and poster number at the top of the poster board to allow viewers to identify your poster. Please consider using large font size in texts, diagrams, charts and tables for easy viewing at the distance of 1-2 meters. A successful poster presentation depends on how well you convey information to an interested audience. Please make sure to include the background of your research followed by results and conclusions.

The poster help booth and staff will be available to provide assistance and supplies such as pins, and tape at the poster area. Posters should be set up between noon – 13:30 on the December 19, 2015 and must remain up the entire afternoon. Please do not remove posters before 18:00. Presenters must be available for at least 1 hour between 16:00 and 18:00. After the poster presentation session, posters must be removed by 18:30.

Publication

Publication opportunities for qualified presentations in International Conference on Global Change, Environment, and Sustainability are available potentially as peer reviewed paper in an issue of Journal of Environmental Management. The submission deadline for publication will be addressed during the conference.
